The general objective of the project is to give citizens the opportunity to discover the cultural diversity of the European Union and to make them aware that European values and cultural heritage constitute the foundation for a common future, to share good practices and foster the citizens the sense of belonging to the EU.

The event aims to bring together **citizens and decision makers** at local and national levels to exchange and share their experiences and results on all aspects of the linguistic and cultural sector. It also provides an interdisciplinary platform for policy makers, citizens and civil society representatives to present and discuss the most recent measures and concerns as well as practical challenges encountered and solutions adopted in the field. Themes for the event revolved around the linkages between issues and policy responses in the field which support contemporary and innovative initiatives that engender experimentation and renewal in cultures, and provided opportunities for participants to actively engage in and reflect upon diversity.
